38 Sight Words from Dolch Word List		
Ask and Answer questions about a story read aloud or independently; read and retell with words and phrases with prompting and support		
Name author and illustrator of a story and identify their roles. How do the pictures support the story?		
Understand that you read left to right, top to bottom, front to back of book; left to right pattern of writing		
Rhyme words; count and blend syllables; poems, rhymes, songs, stories with repeated patterns; Add delete and substitute target sounds (rhyming words and word families)

Phonetically spelled words		
Write letters in their names		
Use combo of drawing and dictating to write an event in order and provide a reaction; adding details		
Capitalize first word in sentence and pronoun I. Punctuate end of sentence with period		
Distinguish between similarly spelled words (cat and bat; tap/map)

Count 1-100; by ones and tens; count on from a given number		
Write, recognize, and represent a set of numerals 1-20 including zero as a count of none		
One to one correspondence ; Compare sets of numbers represented with objects		
Classify and count objects into categories and sort categories by count

Place value from ones to tens up to 19		
Identify and count out pennies within 20		

When presented with written numbers, compare two numbers between 1-10 represented with objects		
Identify number of objects greater than, less than or equal to number of objects in another group
